Legal basis of processing

The processing of sensitive and personal data will be carried out on one or more of the following legal bases:

- Explicit consent of the data subject

- Performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the data controller
- Legitimate interests pursued by the data controller or by a third party
